## Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Minutes of Twentieth IQAC Meeting held on 02-02-2020 at 10:30 A.M in the Conference Hall.

The following points were discussed and decisions taken place in the Meeting:

1. **Review of minutes of the Nineteenth IQAC meeting held on 01-11-2019.**

Reviewed minutes of the Nineteenth IQAC meeting held on 01-11-2019.

2. **Review of the activities conducted in between 01.11.2019 - 02.02.2020.**

Several activities were conducted during the mentioned period by various departments. The details are enclosed.

3. **Discussion on Academic Audit reports of 18-19 and actions taken.**

The academic audit reports of academic year 18-19 were discussed. Each year, the college conducts an academic audit of each department and various committees through IQAC in order to improve and maintain the quality of education. The Committee formed with HODs of Department, and Academic peers as members evaluated once in an academic session as per the academic plan, reviewed their academic progress and submitted a report.

The academic audit consists of T-L Process, Use of ICT tools, Technical seminar, Internships, training, Industrial visit, Co-curricular and Extra-curricular activities, Extension Activities, Project work, Parents Teacher Meeting, Department Events, Research Work, Counseling and Mentoring, Alumni, Placement Details, MoU Activities, College Level Events are considered for evaluation.

4. **Discussion on identifying and supporting academically weak students and encouraging bright students.**

In each semester, the slow and advanced learners are identified based on the previous semester's results and midterm examinations. The respective HoDs prepare a list of academically weak students and encourage bright students.

**HoDs reported the initiatives they are following in order to assist slow learners**

- Tutorial/Remedial classes are conducted for the courses after the MID-I exam.
- In order to improve their understanding of the concepts, students are divided into groups and discussed among themselves.
- Conducting unit tests for every completed unit so the student can prepare easily for the end-of-semester exam.



**HoDs reported the Initiatives they are following for Motivating Advanced Learners**

- Advanced learners have adequate resources at the institute to explore their knowledge, including a Project Lab, an IoT Lab, etc. with the assistance of faculty who has experience in these areas.
- Students are encouraged to enroll in online certification courses such as NPTEL SWAYAM, IIT BOMBAY SPOKEN TUTORIAL, COURSERA, UDEMY, edX, etc.
- Project/Research labs are available even after class hours.
- They are encouraged and supported to attend conferences, workshops, project expos, and hackathons.
- Students are also encouraged to participate in events organized by professional bodies such as CSI (Computer Society of India), IEEE (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers), and IETE (Institute of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers).
- Students are nominated to serve on college-level committees.

**5. Discussion of the Student Support System for mentoring.**

Dean academics informed that the institute adopted a well-defined mentoring process where each faculty mentor is assigned with a maximum of 12 students. Through personal interaction, faculty mentors understand each student's strengths, need, and difficulties. If the student finds any difficulty in any subject, the mentor will take the initiation of facilitating the interaction of the student with concerned faculty. The mentor's counsel is based on the student problems other than academics too.

HoDs informed that a mentoring diary proposed by the IQAC for each student is maintained for four years to record the details such as attendance, marks, backlogs, add-on courses done, papers published, conferences/workshops attended, etc., along with mentor remarks. The mentor updates the above details once every fortnight.

**6. Discussion on IQAC Quality Initiatives with reference to use and enrichment of ICT infrastructure.**

IQAC has advised the administration to enhance ICT infrastructure by purchasing advanced ICT tools and broadband internet Wi-Fi facilities. Periodically IQAC has trained teachers and non-teaching staff to use ICT by conducting different workshops.

As per the latest trends, the Institute is equipped with 100% ICT-enabled classrooms and seminar halls. There is a digital library on campus with free internet access. Students and faculty have access to e-journals, e-books, NPTEL, DELNET, NDL, Moodlecloud, and Coursera via this system. There was a discussion of feedback on teaching and learning.



7. **Discussion on applying for B. Tech Computer Science and Engineering (AI&ML) with intake 60 in the place of reduction of intake in B. Tech Mechanical Engineering course from 120 to 60 students from the academic year 2020-21 from AICTE & JNTUH.**

IQAC committee discussed and accepted for above proposal of reduction of intake in B. Tech Mechanical Engineering course from 120 to 60 students from the academic year 2020-21 from AICTE & JNTUH.

Feedbacks were collected from the students at four levels: institutional level, department level, teacher level, and curriculum-based. Department and teacher feedbacks were discussed in the department meetings. HoDs presented the analyzed data at the department level.

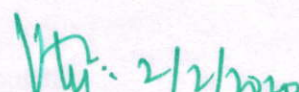

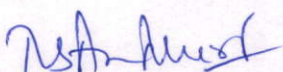

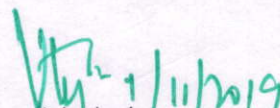
